Purpose of the meeting was to discuss implications of running temporary camp sites (rallies) this year due to COVID regulations.

Heather(acting secretary) attended an MCC zoom meeting re the regulations for running a temporary campsite.

There are 2 very detailed risk assessments, 1 for commercial sites and 1 for non-commercial sites.(received 7-8-20)

There are a lot of things to put in place to be able to run a temporary campsite to mitigate the risk of Covid-19.

Due to the shortness of the season and the time involved to put all necessary precautions in place it was decided by the committee to not run an official MCC temporary campsite this year. Due to no rallies, coffee mornings, no groups of more than 6 people socialising with social distancing etc.

Friendly meets are not under the umbrella of the MCC and will be run as and when a member decides to attend a site and want others to be informed so that they can book themselves into the campsite if they would like to camp with others. As these are not MCC meets anyone can join in eg. Friends and family. People will be responsible for their own booking and payment to the site and for their own Health & Safety. 3 of these meets have occurred (the old barn - 4 vans attended), Kingsclere – 3 vans attended and the Fighting Cocks – 8 vans attended).
